

Award:

Trade and Apprenticeship Student Scholarship:

Five (5) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to individuals who are currently attending or will be attending a technical center, trade school, or enrolling in an apprenticeship program centered around the construction industry.

Manufactured Home Resident Scholarship:

Two (2) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors, GED recipients, or students who are currently enrolled in college, technical schools, or trade schools. Eligible participants must live in a modular or manufactured home.

Application Instructions:

Trade and Apprenticeship Student Scholarship:

This completed application must be accompanied by an original, type-written 300-word essay explaining why you want to enter into the construction industry and what you hope to obtain from your schooling and/or training; a copy of your high school, GED, or college transcript, and three letters of reference from business persons, clergy, or community leaders. Only one of these may be from a school administrator or teacher. You may copy the included sheet for your letters of reference OR attach your individually typed letters of reference. In order to be considered, the complete application, with essay and references, must be postmarked to KMHI by April 6, 2020.

Manufactured Home Resident Scholarship:

This completed application must be accompanied by an original type-written 300-word essay explaining the impact of factory-built housing on your life, a copy of your high school, GED, or college transcript, and three letters of reference from business persons, clergy, or community leaders. Only one of these may be from a school administrator or teacher. You may copy the included sheet for your letters of reference OR attach your individually typed letters of reference. In order to be considered, the complete application, with essay and references, must be postmarked to KMHI by April 6, 2020.

Award Selection:

Selection is based on the essay response, scholastic grades, community involvement, honors, recommendations, and personal goals. Judges' decision is final. Alternates will be selected and move to first place should a winner be disqualified, receive a full scholarship from another source, or decide not to further his/her education. A tie may result in a call for personal interviews.

Recipients and those who are not chosen for this scholarship will be notified via mail towards the end of May.
