

Fine Arts Scholarship

Purpose: To encourage students under the jurisdiction of the Monroe County School System who have participated in the Fine Arts and are interested in furthering their education, preferably in the Fine Arts, the Monroe Arts Council will award up to \$500 in Scholarship money.

Criteria:

1. 3.0 GPA or better on a 4.0 scale (attach a transcript of grades)
2. Must provide a sample of student's work (suggestions: a student's writing, art work or a tape/video of musical or dramatic performance)
3. Must include one recommendation from a teacher.
4. Must enroll in a post-secondary school for the Fall Semester 2020 (although the scholarship recipient will be announced at Awards Night, the recipient will not receive the money until he/she submits a validation of enrollment from the school he/she is attending).
5. Application Deadline: April 24, 2020.
6. Application and other required materials should be taken to the high school guidance office before the end of the school day on April 24, 2020.
